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KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan, deliver and evaluate engaging programs across Stages 4, 5 and 6, compliant with NESA requirements and taught from a Biblical perspective.
- Deliver Stage 6 Physics with academic rigour, preparing students well for the HSC and further study.
- Plan, conduct and supervise practical investigations safely, maintaining laboratory safety standards and caring for faculty equipment.
- Foster a positive, child safe classroom culture with clear expectations, differentiating learning and liaising with Learning Support so every student is appropriately supported.
- Implement quality assessment practices, monitoring student progress and reporting accurately and on time.
- Care pastorally for students so each is known, seen and loved; communicate with parents in line with school policy; and contribute to faculty planning and to the pastoral, co-curricular and outdoor education programs.

CHILD SAFETY

At SHCS, child safety is inseparable from who we are. Our commitment that every student is known, seen and loved means building a culture where children are safe, listened to, and confident that any concern they raise will be taken seriously and acted upon.
